How to Apply

- Application window: December 1, 2026–February 15, 2027

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- Ask your references to:
 - Go online
 - Download the Reference Questionnaire
 - Complete it
 - Save it
 - Email it back to you.

You will need to upload the completed reference forms with your other application materials.

- By submitting the application, the applicant confirms the information is true and correct.

Application Must Include

- Completed Scholarship Application form
- One (1) Academic Reference written within the past six months
- One (1) Non-Academic Reference from an unrelated personal or business associate written within the past six months
- Unofficial college transcript(s) verifying appropriate criteria have been met. Transcripts from more than one college may be submitted.

Additional Information

- Finalists will be notified in April by a member of Assistance League of Sacramento.
- Finalists must email an unofficial transcript(s) dated between May 1–7, 2025, to scholarship@alsacramento.org.
- Finalists must show a valid California Driver's License or California ID to their Assistance League of Sacramento liaison in April.
- Recipients and guests will be invited to a reception in May, when they will receive their checks.
- Questions may be directed to scholarship@alsacramento.org.
- Applicants who were not selected will not be notified.
- Assistance League Scholarship Committee keeps these applications for three (3) years, then they are shredded.
- Assistance League members and their families are not eligible for these scholarships.
